

Sunday, September 4th, 2016 The Holy Spirit: Our Guide

We have spent the past 4 weeks learning about **the person of the Holy Spirit**, how He **renews our hearts**, how gives us great and marvelous **gifts**, and what **fruits** are evidenced though a life in connection with Him. This week we try to answer the question; "How do I know when the Holy Spirit is leading me?"

In what common everyday ways has the Spirit led you recently?

Read John 16:12-15 together as a group; reading from two or three different translations.

- In what ways does Jesus say, in this passage, that the Holy Spirit will guide us?
- How do we see the Trinity expressed in this scripture passage?

The Holy Spirit promises to speak both to our present situation and our future hope in Jesus. He amplifies both the ways and will of Jesus in our world.

How are these promises of the Spirit encouraging to Christ followers?

The Holy Spirit will never lead us to sin, nor will it contradict the Word of God. **The Bible will never be missing from the Spirit leading us.** 

- In what ways is comfort and convenience NOT a value of the Holy Spirit?
- When have you chosen your own voice over the leading of the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit speaks through God's Word, 100% of the time. He communicates through the Bible, so he can bring clarity to our lives through the scripture.

- How do you make space to let God's Word led you currently? Share with the group what your rhythms and disciplines are for reading the Bible consistently.
- In what specific ways has the Holy Spirit prompted you towards joining God's work around you?

The Holy Spirit is promised to speak to us in the way we can hear it. He brings clarity, not confusion. This leading of the Holy Spirit is a gift of Jesus, not a mark of our spiritual maturity.
