

September 11th, 2016 | Praxis: Mission

The **Book of Acts** records the growth of the very first church. In chapter 1 of Acts, Jesus is exiting this earth and preparing the church for all that would come next. **It's the beginning of the church!**

- Why do you go to church?
 - (Take time for real reflection about what motivates you to get up on Sunday Morning, sing songs, listen to teaching, serve in your community, and attend a group in someone's home.)

What is the church? The church is anyone who has been made new by following Jesus, collectively living under the mission of God. **The People of God on the Mission of God.**

• In what ways is it possible that people <u>AT</u> the church are actually not <u>IN</u> the church?

As a group, **read Acts 1:4-9** together as a group. This text establishes the two main purposes of the church. To **put God at the center through worship**, and to **be a witness to the world** around them.

- How does Jesus' command to "wait for the promise" establish the purpose of the church to worship Him? (vs. 4-5)
- What role does worship play in putting God in His proper place?
- To whom do we have the responsibility to live as a witness for?

Our purpose is found in keeping God centered in our practices and His mission spreading throughout the world. Every church attempts to be led by these two guiding principles.

- What practices do you see at Grace Community Church that specifically attempt to put God at the center of all that we do?
- As you've been involved in the mission of Grace Community Church, has your heart been increasingly drawn towards the things of God? In what ways specifically.
- How does the witness of a changed life affect those inside and outside of the church?

We want our understanding of the world to compel us to be strong faithful witnesses for **Jesus.** No matter how "good" anyone appears to be, we are all in need of His Grace.

How does God want you to be a better worshiper and witness for him?
