

Mark: A Journey with Jesus | | Jesus Walks on Water Mark 6:45-52

We have been in Mark now for a couple of months and the recurring message is that **Mark is teaching us** what it means to follow Jesus, to be His disciple.

• How would you define a disciple? What are the characteristics and qualities of a disciple of Jesus?

Read Mark 6:45-52 as a group; be sure to focus in on what you think are key words in this passage.

- Why do you think Jesus commanded the disciples to get on a boat, go to the other side and rest?
- Reread verse 48: Is there anything significant in this verse that stands out to you?

Our expectations affect what we think reality should be. Many times, our spirits are crushed because our expectations are not met.

- Do you think the disciples expected to encounter a storm since they were following Jesus' command?
- Have you ever experienced a time in your life where you were being obedient to what the Lord called you to do yet you encountered storms along the way?
 - o If so, how did you handle it and how did it make you feel?

The pattern established in this story, is a pattern for our lives with Jesus. He gives a command, we make painful progress and struggle, we may feel abandoned, God's command still stands, and then Jesus gives a rescue, ultimately giving us what we really needed.

- Could anyone give out an example of this pattern showing itself in his or her lives?
 - {Command—Struggle—Feeling Abandoned—Command—Rescue}

Scripture is clear that following Jesus will result in having struggles in our life. Even though God may not bring you out of the struggle, He has promised that He will walk through them with you.

- Knowing this truth, how does it make your feel about your own relationship with Jesus?
- In what struggle, do you do you currently feel an invitation from God to grow?

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
