

Four Choices: Love Sunday, February 7th, 2016

Read Mark 2: 1-12 together as a group. Re-read verses 5 and 12 separately for emphasis.

Detail the actions of selfless and selfish love found in this passage?

When you read this passage what comes to mind as the most important truth?

A **belonging love** is that which we choose to give and receive in authentic community.

Where do you see yourself attracted to community, friendship, and relationship? Use examples in media, television, work environments, etc...

Do you have any real spiritual friendships? How would you advise another to find meaningful community and friendship?
