

November 6th, 2016 Praxis: Generosity

In the early church in the book of Acts, we see them moved towards living generously. One of the results of generosity in God's Kingdom is the ability for **God to use it to do great things.** 

- What moves Christians to give to their local church?
- **Read Acts 4:32-37** together as a group. What moved the early church towards generosity?

One reason we give is simply because **God commands us to be generous**. By obeying his commandments we find freedom. We find freedom from our own selfish desires.

- **Read Malachi 3:10-12** together as a group. In Malachi, God's people were worried about their futures.
  - How does this passage offer relief for that anxiety?
- What does Malachi 3:10-12 tell us will happen to the people that give generously?

Another reason why we give is to **share the responsibility for doing spiritual work.** Our gifts brought to the local church allows us to do the work of introducing people to Jesus and leading them in a life lived for his glory!

- In what ways does generosity help God's cause throughout the world?
- What steps are you taking, or do you need to take, to give sacrificially?
  - What makes giving to the local church hard for you and your family?
- How does generosity become a response from our heart to what God has done for us?

We cannot separate true abandonment to Jesus from radical generosity. Living a Christian life of being generous leads to a freedom that releases us from selfishness and fear of the future.

Reread the above statement a few times as a group. What are your thoughts?
