

Praxis: Sharing Our Story

As Christians, the heart of our faith is conversion. There is brokenness in our lives that has been made right. We have been translated from death to life, from dark to light.

- *When do you most feel convicted to share the story of your conversion?*
- *Why is it hard for you to communicate your faith in Jesus?*

As a group read **John 4:27-42**, then reread verses **27-30** and **39-42**.

- *What do we learn about the woman Jesus meets at the well?*
- *Why would it be scandalous for Jesus to be talking to her?*
- *How does the woman become a witness to what she experienced with Jesus?*
- *How does this story create a framework for us to share our own story of Faith?*

Stories told through relationship matter, they draw us in and move our hearts. When we encounter people in need of Jesus, we can use our story to introduce the change that the Gospel has had on our own lives.

- *When have you been moved by someones story of conversion and faith? Can you retell the details that drew you in?*
- *In what ways does a personal story present the cold, hard facts in a shareable way?*

Evangelism is helping people know Jesus because you love them, knowing that **then they stay with Jesus because He loves them.**

- *When have you most recently missed an opportunity to share your faith story? Why in this specific instance did you choose to stay silent?*

Pray as a group, for the areas you identify together, as places in need of hearing your faith story. Pray that God would enable each of you to have confidence in our faith story, and courage to share in all the areas of our life that God gives us to live in.
