- What do each of these say about how God feels about joy?
- Read **Philippians 4:3**, what does Paul encourage us to do in this passage?

God is holy and just, but he is also good and joyful. Jesus wants to create joy wherever he is.

- Do you find that truth easy to embrace, or is it difficult, and why?
- What makes it hard for us to embrace both holiness and happiness together day by day?
- What attempts do we make to create our own joy and happiness?
- Where do our own efforts toward joy outside of the joy God gives lead us?

The root of most of our lack of joy is centered around us pursuing other things (experiences, money, prestige, and power) to satisfy us. **Jesus is who brings satisfying joy!**
