



Mark: A Journey with Jesus || He is Able!

Mark 3:22-30

We have been in the book of Mark now for six weeks, studying about Jesus coming to earth to replace religion with a personal relationship with Him.

- *What is one truth that you have taken from this series at this point?*

Read Mark 3:22-30 together as a group

- *What is the conversation about between Jesus and the religious scribes?*
- *Why might you find this passage difficult to understand?*

There are three parts to what Jesus says. First, He gives a defense of His actions. Second, He gives them an explanation and finally, He gives a warning to their hearts.

- *How did Jesus defend his actions and why was it important for Him to do that?*
- *If Jesus is showing them that He is able to do all things, why would the scribes or even us choose to not believe who He says He is?*

In the last part of this passage, Jesus mentions that there is one unforgivable sin and it is blasphemy against the Holy Spirit.

- *What does blasphemy mean? How do we blaspheme against the Holy Spirit?*
- *Pride is what kept the religious scribes from believing in who Jesus was. Have you ever had a time in your life where your struggle with pride prevented you from believing in Jesus? Please share your story with the group.*
- *What are ways that we can prevent our hearts from becoming prideful and hardened to the Holy Spirit?*
