## Read Mark 10:1-12 together as a group.

- Why were the Pharisees trying to trap Jesus with their question about divorce?
- How do you think they handled the answer that Jesus gave them?
- Is there anything about Jesus' answer that is confusing to you?

In our text Jesus refers to men having a hardened heart. Every problem in society and in our own lives conceivably begins with this hardness of heart.

- How would you specifically define a hardened heart?
- Why would a hardened heart be the root cause of people getting divorced?
- In our marriages, how do we practically keep an eye out for our own hardness of heart?

For a marriage to work, you must allow the Lord to soften your heart instead of letting it grow inflexible towards God. Divorce is a mess, yet God takes things that aren't the way they're supposed to be and forces his mercy and grace inside.

- When has there been a time in your life that God has taken your messy and made something beautiful?
- Why is sadness and sorrow an important emotion to hold about divorce?
- Where does God want to push his grace into your heart today?
