Mark 16:1-8

Take a minute to think about all the Easters you may have celebrated during your childhood.

- *Share one of your favorite memories of Easter as a kid or what is one of your favorite Easter traditions you did with family?*
- *Do you remember when you really begin to understand what Easter meant and why as Christians, we celebrate it?*

Read Mark 16:1-8 together as a group and choose at three different translations

- *What are the different ways the translations describe how the women responded to not finding Jesus in the tomb and the stone rolled away?*
- *As a Christian, why is this event important to understand?*

The good news is that Jesus conquered death and rose from the grave. According to Revelation 21:1-5, there will be a new earth and a new heaven and the old will be gone. God will do away with all evil.

- *While this truth brings us comfort, the reality is we are all evil. How does Christ's death and resurrection keep us from being wiped away?*
- *Do you believe that God's grace and mercy are for all people? What are you doing to help share the gospel with others?*
