



Faith, Hope and Love || Hope for Yourself and Others

John 3:1-8

As we continue looking at hope, you may struggle with having hope for yourself. Questioning if you can change or will things ever get better for yourself.

- *Why do you think that people usually say that change will make things better?*
- *If change is inevitable for each of us, how can change bring you hope?*

Read John 3:1-8 out loud with your group

- *How do you explain what it means to be born again?*
- *Why is this passage significant in understanding the Christian faith?*

Being born again is the beginning of new life in Christ. Accepting Jesus as your Savior allows you to begin again with Him leading your life.

- *Should your life look different to others when you are born again in Christ? Why or why not?*

Our hope is in Christ and the fact that we are regenerating in Him every day. He is worth imitating and the main desire in our lives should be to know Him more.

- *How do we get to know God more and grow in our faith in Him?*
- *What does it look like to truly seek Him?*

In your group, challenge yourself and each other to ask the question to someone, “Where have you seen me change?” Take some time this week to go before the Lord and ask Him, “Where do you need me to change?” Be willing to come back to your group with the answer the Lord gave you.
