Read I Timothy 6:6-10 with your group

- Both of the themes from the OT and NT are true but how can they be since they have such different meanings?
- Why is it important for us to have a biblical view of money?

Look up the first two of the ten commandments that God gave in Exodus 20 and read them together as a group.

How are these two commandments a road map for us in knowing God?

Money has the power to disconnect us from having hearts for God. Two things that we need to do daily is *pay attention to our hearts* and to *give sacrificially*. Which of these two things do you need to work on this week? Share with your group and spend time praying for each other.
