All of us are born to parents and all of us have some type of family. Our families may look different from each other but family is seen as a sacred creation by God. He established it in the Old Testament with Adam, Eve and their children.

- What does it mean to you to hear that your family is sacred?
- What would be the biblical response in how you treat your sacred family?

## Read Proverbs 23:15-26 together as a group

Which part of that scripture really speaks to you personally and why?

Many people come from broken homes or have an absent parent, which makes it difficult to understand what Christ-like parenting should have or does look like. God is saddened by this brokenness.

- How can a person learn more about God through their broken family situation?
- What would you say to encourage someone who has an unhealthy view of parenting?

The Lord makes every child unique and each of them has a deep capacity for good and for evil. It is a parent's job to parent them accordingly and to help them be who they already are.

- If you are a parent, how does that truth resonate with you and how you are parenting?
- How do you feel that your parents did with raising you according this truth?

Three things that parents pass on to their kids are faith (vivid awareness of God), wisdom and habits that lead to character.

- Why are these three things important to pass on to your kids?
- Which one do you feel you really need to be working on? Share with the group and pray for each other to follow through.
