

The Greatest Commandment

Bible Story: The Greatest Commandment • *Matthew 22:36-40; 1 Corinthians 13*

Bottom Line: You can LIVE for God by loving others.

Memory Verse: “Let us keep looking to Jesus. He is the one who started this journey of faith. And he is the one who completes the journey of faith.” *Hebrews 12:2a (NIV)*

Life App: Faith—Trusting in what you can't see because of what you can see

Basic Truth: I should treat others the way I want to be treated.

Crafts: Exploring Biblical Truths Through Creativity

Tissue Paper Photo Frame

What You Need: “Day 5 Bottom Line Labels” Activity Page, photo frames, paint, paintbrushes, markers, photo of your child.

What You Do:

- Remove the backing from each frame and set it aside.
- Have kids paint, draw, or coloring anything they want on their frames. Encourage them to be creative.
- When they are finish have them put the “Bottom Label” on their frame.
- When you have time, take a picture of your child and place it in the frame.

What You Say:

“What did you learn about God this week at Grace Kids Camp? (*Pause for responses.*) How can you love others this week? (*Pause.*) Can it be hard to love others? (*Pause.*) Loving others is important; we all need to be loved. Let's say today's Bottom Line: **[Bottom Line] You can LIVE for God by loving others.** Let's place your photo frame someplace you can see it and remember our time at Grace Kids Camp and how **[Bottom Line] you can LIVE for God by loving others.**”

Connection Time

Use the following questions to keep the conversation going and to keep kids thinking about what they're learning!

- What was your favorite part of Grace Kids Camp?
- Did you find out anything new about God that you didn't know before?
- How are you going to live for God by loving others this coming week?
