What You Need: "Camera," "Story Strip," and "Parent Note" Activity Pages; cardstock; colored pencils; scissors; utility knife; and a pen


What You Do:

Encourage children to color their story strip with the colored pencils. Help insert the story strip into the camera and show them how to slide it side to side to see the story. Review the Bible story with your child

What You Say:

"Today we are making something special to help us remember the most amazing thing Jesus did for me and you. Look on your story strip. Tell me what you see in the first square. (*Pause.*) That's right, it's the stone—the one that was rolled in front of the tomb Jesus was placed in. Color that picture. (*Pause.*) What's on the next square? (*Pause.*) Numbers! What numbers do you see? (*Pause.*) One, two, three. Jesus went away for three days. Color that picture. (*Pause.*) On the last square, what do you see? (*Pause.*) Yes! It's Jesus! Jesus is standing in front of the empty tomb. Yay! Jesus did what He said He would! He went away and came back. Color that picture. (*Pause.*) Great job! Now watch this. (*Insert the story strips into the cameras and pull the strip to reveal the pictures.*) You give it a try and tell me all the things you see. (*Pause.*) Great job! You just told me the Bible story we heard today. Jesus came back just like He said He would. He came back so He could be our friend forever. Who wants to be your friend forever? [*Bottom Line*] Jesus wants to be my friend forever."
